



Kindergarten through 12th Grade Tuition/Fee Schedule for 2021-2022

Tuition for the 2021-2022 School year:

- PCS Tuition includes the book fee, planner fee, and art fee but excludes application and registration fees payable per child.
- The following amounts do not reflect the early re-enrollment discount (\$500 per child), if applicable. Early re-enrollment discounts are not given for Kindergarten. Financial accounts also must be current in order to qualify for this discount.
- There are no multiple child tuition discounts.
- We encourage families to apply for tuition assistance if there is a financial need.

*Application fees apply to new students only.

Payment Options:

- **If you are paying monthly** (10 equal payments **August-May**, through the FACTS program), your monthly debit amount will be as indicated in the table below under monthly: *(does not include the FACTS fee)*.
- **If you are paying semi-annually** (two equal payments in **July and January**, through the FACTS program), your semi-annual debit amount will be as indicated in the table below under semi-annually: *(does not include FACTS fee)*.
- **If you are paying annually** (one payment due by **July 7, 2021**, paid to Providence Classical School), you will receive a 1½ % discount on tuition. Your annual payment due will be as indicated in the table below under annually.
- **Credit/debit card fees:** a 3% convenience fee will be added for credit/debit card use.

Note: With the passage of the 2017 Tax Cuts & Jobs Act, starting in 2018, 529 Accounts can be used for up to \$10,000 in tuition expenses annually in elementary and secondary schools.
