Alternatively, you may also record your child verbally reporting on two of the books he/she read in lieu of written reports (and still turn in 1 written report). This verbal articulation is also an important skill to practice. You can mail or email the (oral and written) reports to Tobi Wiseman (twiseman@pcsvirginia.org) throughout the summer.

2nd Grade Parents, please select at least one book you and your child will read and discuss together. One of your child's book reports may be from a book you read together.
