

Student Supply List: 2024-2025 Junior Kindergarten

- * Sturdy backpack (approx. 15" x 12") and lunch tote labeled with child's name
- 2 boxes 8 count CRAYOLA Crayons Washable Large (NO OFF BRANDS PLEASE)
- 2 boxes 8 count washable markers
- 4 containers of play doh (different colors)
- * 1 pair of Fiskars scissors (labeled w/name)
- * 1 hard plastic pencil box (labeled w/name)
- * 1 soft side pencil pouch (labeled w/name)
- * 1 folder with pockets (labeled w/name)
- 2 sets of watercolors w/brush (washable)
- 1 pack dry erase markers (thin tipped Astro Brights primary colors not neon, multi-color, washable if desired)
- 1 pack multi-colored card stock
- 1 pack white card stock
- 1 box of round "My first Ticonderoga #2 pencils"
- 1 box of Ticonderoga Tri-Write wood-cased pencils
