1st Grade Parents, your child may read as many books with you as he/she would like! However, in order to earn a no-uniform pass, they should choose three books to write a brief report sharing: (1) a favorite scene summary and (2) their favorite character and why. Each book's report can be just a few sentences long or your child may create illustrations as their report on (1) and (2) above. Alternatively, you may also record your child verbally reporting on two of the books he/she read in lieu of written/ drawn reports (and still turn in 1 written/drawn report). This verbal articulation is also an important skill to practice. You can mail or email the (oral and written/drawn) reports to Tobi Wiseman (twiseman@pcsvirginia.org) throughout the summer.
